



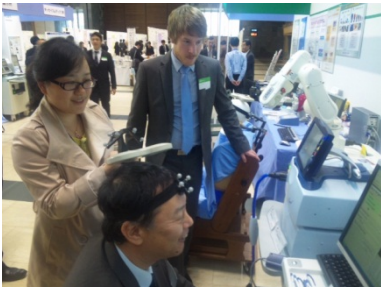
A Tribute to our Friendship

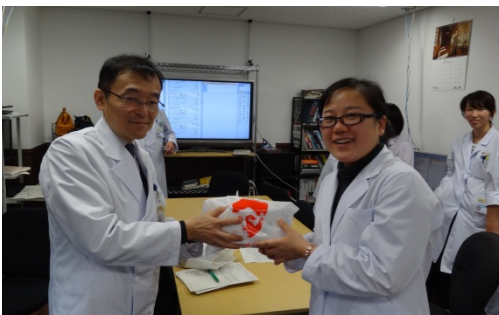
